



## **Lloyd Williamson Nurseries Fee Structure**

### **Academic Year 2025 – 2026**

#### **Registration & Deposit**

School Registration Fee (non-refundable): £ 200

School Acceptance Fee/Deposit: £500

#### **All-Year-Around Fees**

The flat monthly fee is **£2475** per child per month.

If a child attends 1 day per week the fee is £495 per month.

If a child attends 2 days per week the fee is £990 per month.

If a child attends 3 days per week the fee is £1485 per month.

If a child attends 4 days per week the fee is £1980 per month.

If a child attends 5 days per week the fee is £2475 per month.

#### **Term time only Fees**

5 days/week £7050/term

(1 day/week: £1410/term)

## **Government Funding Information – Additional Details**

Government funding covers only the cost of providing childcare and delivering the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) curriculum and only 33 weeks/ year. It does not include the wider range of services and enhancements that our nurseries provide. These additional elements include, but are not limited to:

- Nappies, formula and other consumables
- Additional hours beyond funded entitlement
- Enrichment and extracurricular activities
- Music/French /Studio Cultivate sessions
- Administration and operational costs
- Access to our parent app
- All those little extras that make our nurseries such warm, enriching environments

To ensure these services can continue during funded hours, we ask parents to contribute through our consumables charge, known as the 'Extras and Essentials' fee. This contribution helps us maintain the high quality of care and experiences we offer to all children and families

## **Extras and Essentials / Additional Services Fee**

This fee remains voluntary. However, if a family chooses not to contribute or is unable to do so, we ask that they speak directly with the Nursery Manager (ramona@lws.org.uk). Non-payment does have both operational and financial implications for the nursery.

We do offer Fully Funded or Funded Entitlement Only (FEO) places, subject to availability and provided within a set booking pattern. Families accessing these places may not be able to book early starts or late pickups.

## **Giving Notice on Your Child's Place**

Notice of withdrawal must be submitted by email to your Nursery Manager.

- For children attending on a term-time only basis, at least one full term's notice is required.
- For children attending all year round, a three-month notice period applies.

Where a child is accessing a Fully Funded place, the notice period is reduced to four weeks.

### **Tax-Free Childcare**
